Thank you for your interest in transient dockage at Brewer Plymouth Marine.

Brewer's is a full service Marina offering a wide array of Mechanical, Finish, Electrical, Carpentry and Rigging services. We are fortunate to be located in beautiful downtown Plymouth where you will find a wide array of historic sites, stores and restaurants an easy walk from the Marina. In order to have a confirmed reservation a nonrefundable deposit is required. For vessels under 80 feet we require a half of your first nights stay. If your vessel is 80 ft and over prepayment for your entire stay is requested.

To make your reservation please carefully read our rules and regulations and then fill out the reservation form (one per vessel) and return it or just call in the information. Our rates are listed on the reservation form, a nonrefundable deposit is required to hold your space. If you are already a Brewer Customer please let us know as discounts may apply.

Upon receipt we will mail or email a confirmation card to you. Please keep this number with you for your records. 4<sup>th</sup> of July weekend is extremely busy at our marina. If you are requesting space during July 1-5 please fax a completed guest reservation form to 508.746.2883 before April 1<sup>st</sup>. Our Dockmaster will answer your request by the end of May, but please understand we can only take a few boats and we reserve the right to do what is best for our Marina.

We recommend that you check weather forecasts prior to arrival. Plymouth Harbor is exposed to northeast/east winds. You can call us either by phone or radio (the marina monitors Channel 9) and we will try to have one of our dock staff available to assist you. Our usual in season dock office hours are 8:00 am to 6:00 pm seven days a week.

Upon arrival, please check in at the Dock Office and pick up one of our transient folders from our Dockmaster, Chris Smith, for more information on internet and our popular cruising club.

**Rules and Regulations Governing Transient Dockage**  
*Please check in at the Dock Office upon arrival*

In an effort to provide a safe and pleasant atmosphere for the boat owners docking at Brewer's Plymouth Marine, the following rules and regulations are provided for your protection. When a boat enters the marina, the boat crew and guests must comply with all the rules set out herein.

Plymouth Harbor is dangerously exposed to northeast/east winds. We may move or require you to relocate your vessel at our discretion and your risk and cost. Reservation customers are strongly urged to check weather forecasts prior to arrival. We monitor Channel 9.

Only vessels, in a *safe and seaworthy* condition, and under their own power, shall be admitted to berthing areas. In the event of an emergency during the owner's absence, i.e. breakdown of the bilge pump, leak, inadequate dock lines, etc., the ***Dockmaster is authorized to make necessary repairs*** as economically as possible and charge the boat owner for labor and materials.

***Pets shall be leashed*** within the confines of the marina, and toileted on the "Dog Run" area behind the electrical shed. Pets are permitted only if they do not disturb other guests.

***Refuse, shall not be thrown overboard.*** Garbage shall be deposited in containers supplied for that purpose. No person shall discharge oil, spirits, inflammable liquids or oily bilges into the marina. The use of charcoal burners, gas welders, gas torches, or any open flame-producing equipment is prohibited in the marina. No refueling may be accomplished within the berthing area.

***Charcoal grills may only be used within the enclosed area at the head of the gangway.***

***Noise shall be kept to a minimum at all times.*** Patrons shall use discretion in operating engines, generators, radios and television sets so as not to create a nuisance or disturbance. Halyards shall be secured to prevent slating.

***No motorized vehicle*** or bicycle shall be ridden, driven or stored on the docks, walkways, or wood deck from the marina gangway to the dock office.

***Transfer of boats from one slip to another slip shall not be allowed.*** Owner agrees that in case of emergency, marina may move the boat from the particular space rented to any other mooring place.

***Check out time is 11 o'clock.*** Guests checking out of the marina shall report to the Dockmaster's office and settle their account prior to leaving. It will be appreciated if all boat owners will leave a forwarding address in order to permit prompt handling of telephone call or mail. All personal property must be removed from docks when dockage rental is terminated.

***Use your Holding Tank!***

For Your Safety – ***NO SWIMMING AT THE DOCKS.***

Violation of the above rules and regulations, disorder, depredations, or indecorous conduct by a patron, or his crew or guests, that might injure a person or cause damage to property will be cause for immediate removal from the marina of the boat in question



## SERVICE

Brewer Plymouth Marine, though one of the smaller Brewer Yacht Yards, regularly undertakes projects many would assume appropriate for only much larger facilities. We are well-known for our strong mechanical abilities, but we are also widely respected as a top-notch paint and finish facility. In recent years, our crew has also successfully tackled traditional, new boat construction. On the south coast of Massachusetts, you will not find a better place for service.

## FACILITIES/EQUIPMENT

We operate two Travelifts, with 35 and 60-ton capacity, as well as a 14-ton crane with a 70-foot boom. This equipment fully supports the service and storage of nearly 200 boats, on approximately three, well-groomed acres. A brand new 10,000 square foot, state-of-the-art service building also allows us to store up to 38 boats inside, where we can provide complete service in heated comfort, under adequate lighting. One third of our new space, a 33' by 88' bay, has been designated as a paint and fiberglass shop, making this a truly full-service facility.



## MECHANICAL

Whether faced with a major engine refit, a complete fuel tank replacement, or an extensive electrical or systems upgrade, our mechanical staff is fully capable. Our technicians are certified for service on: Cummins, Yanmar, Caterpillar, Westerbeke, Crusader, MerCruiser. We also are dealers for Kohler and Fischer Panda Generators. In addition, we sell and service Marine Air and Cruise Air Systems; SidePower and Vetus bow thrusters; Espar heating equipment; Lewmar, Lofrans, and Maxwell windlasses; and refrigeration systems of all types. Our service qualifications are too great to include mention of all product lines in one list, but suffice it to say, our six-man mechanical team is ready for any job that comes our way.



## REFINISHING

Our two AwlGrip application specialists also manage fiberglass repair and modification, and gelcoat refinishing. Along with our skilled varnish applicator, this crew regularly turns out yacht quality finishes. Whether a result of collision or fire, this crew can return both minor dings and significantly damaged fiberglass to original condition. We also have the ability to repair blister-damaged boats; maintain interior and exterior brightwork; paint bottoms; and buff and wax hulls and superstructures.

## ELECTRICAL

Our electrical service is provided by ABYC certified technicians, who adhere to industry standards. Whether rewiring your boat or installing communications and navigation equipment, we offer a variety of services, including alternator and inverter installations; battery bank hook-ups; and diagnostic trouble shooting.

Our finish carpenter handles both shipwright and cabinetry work. Whether your next woodworking project requires custom fabrication, major modification, or simple trim work, we can help.
